


## **LEAP Action Learning Report 2013**

Topic area (The What)	Instructional leadership and the use of social media within schools.
Context (The Where and When)	Bayview Heights Public School, Pickering, Ontario and a number of elementary and secondary schools within the Durham District School Board.  I also attended professional learning sessions at the Board for teams of teachers to examine and reflect on the data from EQAO (Education Quality and Accountability Office), similar to NAPLAN.  Discussions with teachers, school principals and Durham District School

Initial findings	Instructional leadership Classroom observations "open to learning" are conducted within each school by the administrators (Principal and Vice Principal) Classroom walkthroughs are conducted by the District Superintendent on a regular basis. Each school has a school improvement plan (SIP)  Evidence Based Strategies are embedded in school plans and include:  Learning Goal/ Success Criteria  Inquiry Based Learning  Descriptive Feedback (oral, written)  Big Ideas/Rich Tasks  3 Part Math Lesson  Differentiated Instruction  Anchor/Exemplars  21st Century Technology/Learning  Social Media  Most schools have a school twitter account to communicate with parents and the education community. One school, R.H Cornish PS, @RHCornish PS has established class twitter accounts to share children's learning activities with parents.  I found no evidence of schools and/or the Board using twitter for professional learning.
